TECHNOLOGY

In this Trimester, your child will:

- Create multimedia/video presentations using Library research.
- Expand on the Library's Worldly Book Challenge by creating movies about Civil Rights Activists.
- Use our knowledge from previous years to develop multimedia projects that incorporate a variety of text, image and video edits and features.

VISUAL ART

In this Trimester, your child will:

- Learn and understand how to draw using cross-hatching basics to show value.
