  - 1. *Winter Recess- 3-4 days of recess inside is tough on some kids What policy is in place?* Standard: windchill below 20 requires indoor recess. Donations from PTO have been being successfully used. Kids can go into the library or project room for a quieter experience if they choose.
  - Wonders 2020 How is Wonders 2020 working out now that it has been implemented for 3-years? Will the district continue or investigate a new program? There is a yearly continuous review schedule for all academic areas. Wonders will not be up for a review at this time.
